

# RESULTS OF THE RAPID ASSESSMENT OF COMMUNITIES AND LOCAL NGOs. UKRAINE

June 2023

34 NGOs of Ukraine took part in the survey. That is 68% of the total number of NGOs and community organizations that work in the field of HIV/TB in Ukraine.

The purpose of the operational survey: to identify the existing needs of groups vulnerable to HIV and to assess the capacity of NGOs to develop/improve new areas of assistance in the context of martial law.

To conduct the study, the method of online survey of organizations using the Google Forms web application was used.

The questionnaire contained 3 sections, namely:

- 1. Monthly coverage of the organization's clients from among the key groups of humanitarian aid.
- 2. List of possible needs of NGO clients.
- 3. Capacity and preparedness of the NGOs.
